

## Transfers to Stradbroke Island: Australasian Workshop on Emergent Quantum Matter 2014

If you are not meeting the arranged bus on Monday 24 November

We are travelling with

**Stradbroke Ferries – Vehicle Ferry and Water Taxi.** [www.stradbrokeferries.com.au](http://www.stradbrokeferries.com.au)

This company (which used to be operate as Big Red Cat) operates two services (water taxi and vehicle ferry) both from the terminal at 3 Emmett Drive, Cleveland, and travels to the Harold Walker Jetty Junner Street in Dunwich (this is to the south of the UQ Research Station).

The plan is for pedestrians to take the 10:55am water taxi service to Dunwich. Workshop participants can pick up their return ticket by giving their name at the office on Emmett Drive, where they have been purchased in advance. If you don't catch this service, you can catch any other service up until 4:25pm Monday (the office needs to be open for you to pick up your ticket.)

**Please note that there is a second ferry company – the Stradbroke Flyer – which is NOT the one we are using!**

You will need to make your own way to Toondah Harbour, Cleveland. This is about 30km from the city, and about a \$75 ride in a taxi. Alternatively you can get there by taking the Cleveland line train from the city (eg Central) to the end of the line at Cleveland, for a cost of about \$8.

There is a train from Central Station at 9:17am on Monday 24 November, arriving at Cleveland Station at 10:20am. At 10:31 bus 258 leaves Cleveland station, and arrives at Emmett Drive at Toondah Harbour Ferry, Cleveland at 10:38am, where you can pick up your ferry ticket. If you are nervous about making the connection, the same journey occurs an hour earlier as well.

Information on public transport for Brisbane is available at <http://translink.com.au/> where you will find a full journey planner. You can either buy a single ticket (covers the bus and train), or you can purchase a "Go Card" from a newsagent that you top up with credit, and that you tap on and off every bus and train.

If you are going to take a vehicle to Stradbroke Island, you will need to book and pay for this yourself (it strongly recommended to make a booking in in advance).

### On arrival at Dunwich

There will be organisers there to meet you on arrival. It is about a 10 minute walk to the research station where the workshop is being held. There will be a couple of cars for anyone that needs luggage transfer. Once there, lunch will be served. Then there will be an induction at 1:00pm, after which you can check into your rooms, and the workshop will start at 2pm.

## If you are meeting the arranged bus from the airport on Monday 24 November

### International arrivals:

Meet at/near Spoon Deli/café inside the arrivals hall (see attached map). Once everyone has arrived, please call Red and White Coach Australia on +617 3269 6466 and let them know that the booking for Moreton Bay Research Station is ready to be picked up. Move to the coach pick up zone, near the taxi stand, outside the arrivals area. They are expecting to pick you up at 9am.

### Domestic:

Meet next to the Coffee Club, which is outside the terminal near the overhead walkway to the carparks (see attached map). Once everyone has arrived, please call Red and White Coach Australia on +617 3269 6466 and let them know that the booking for Moreton Bay Research Station is ready to be picked up.

The group should then follow the directions to the coach pick up waiting area. Go over the overhead walkway and follow the signs – to the left of the car park P2. They are expecting you at 9:30am.

Chris Vale (0408885210) and Brenton Hall (0412033712) are in charge.

Any problems, please call Matthew Davis on 0423184082. The bus needs to be in time to catch the 10:55 ferry. If any flights are significantly delayed, the bus will leave without you. Then your best option is probably to take a taxi to Toondah Harbour in Cleveland. Otherwise, you can take the train to Central Station, and switch to the Cleveland line. This will take a lot longer.

Lunch will be as normal 12.15pm – 1.15 pm.

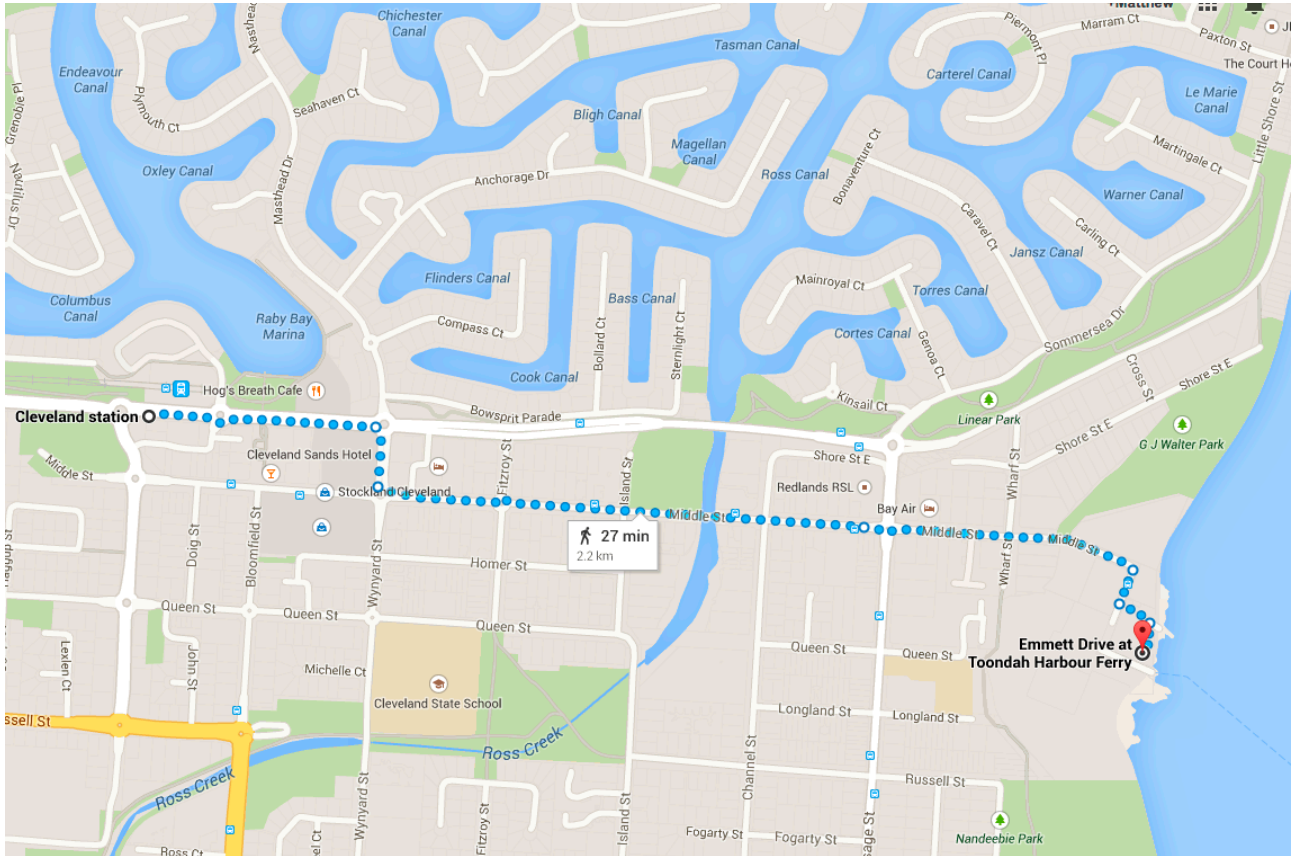
Chartered bus leaves the Moreton Bay Research Station to go to Point Lookout at 1.30 pm.

We are suggesting three options:

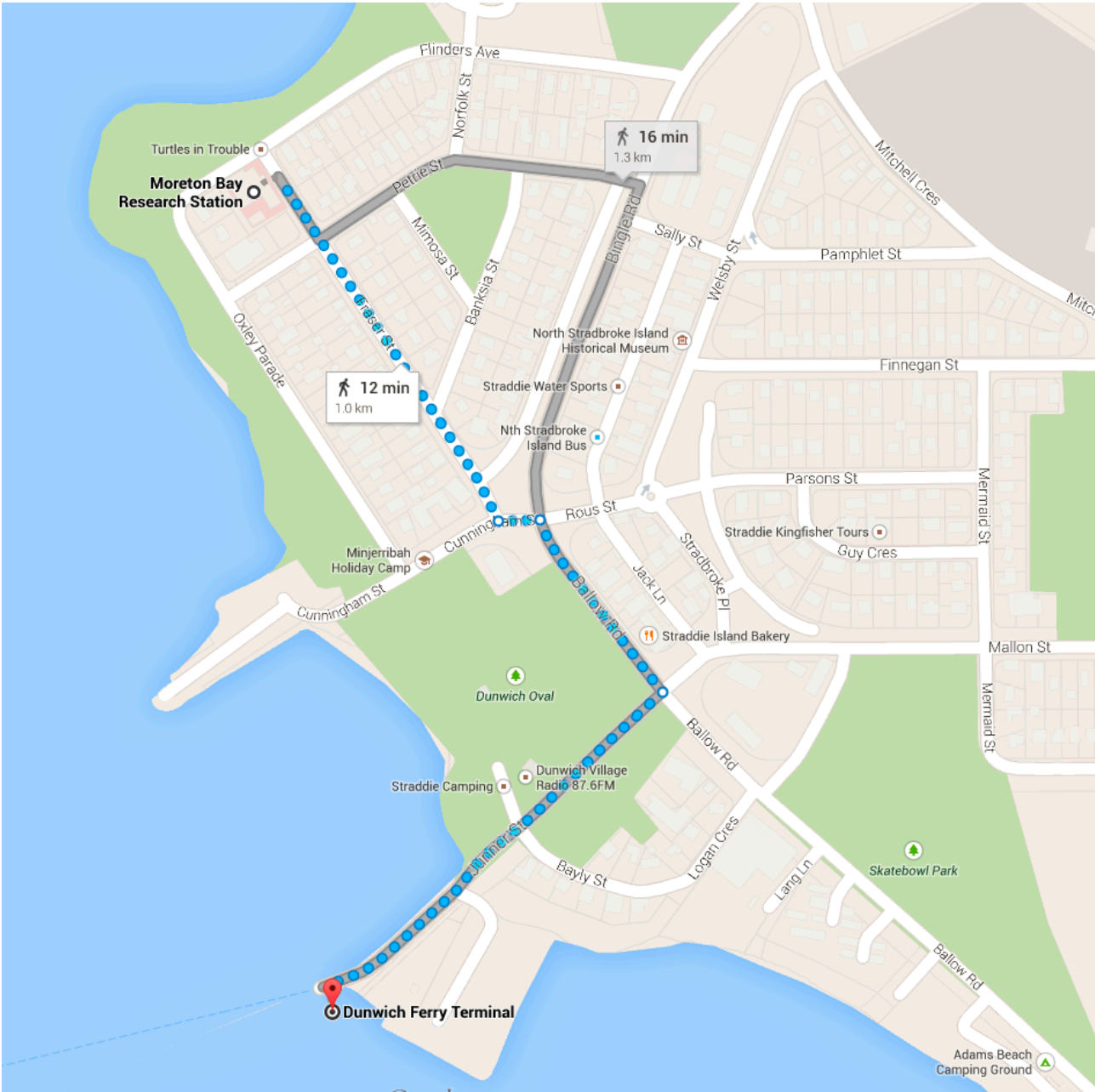

Cost will be \$30 per person, or \$25 if we have a group of ten prebooked. This will be organised on Monday.

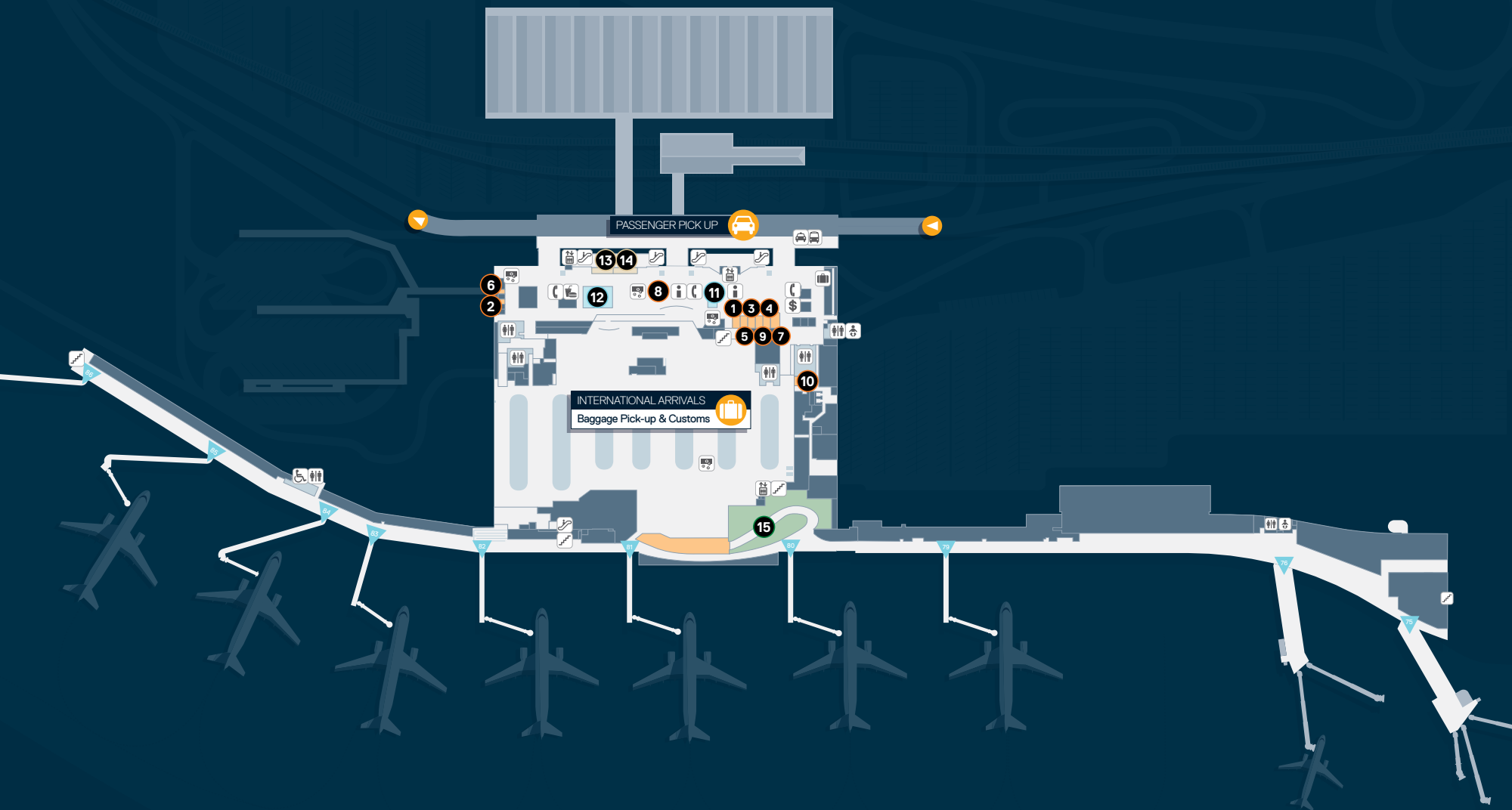

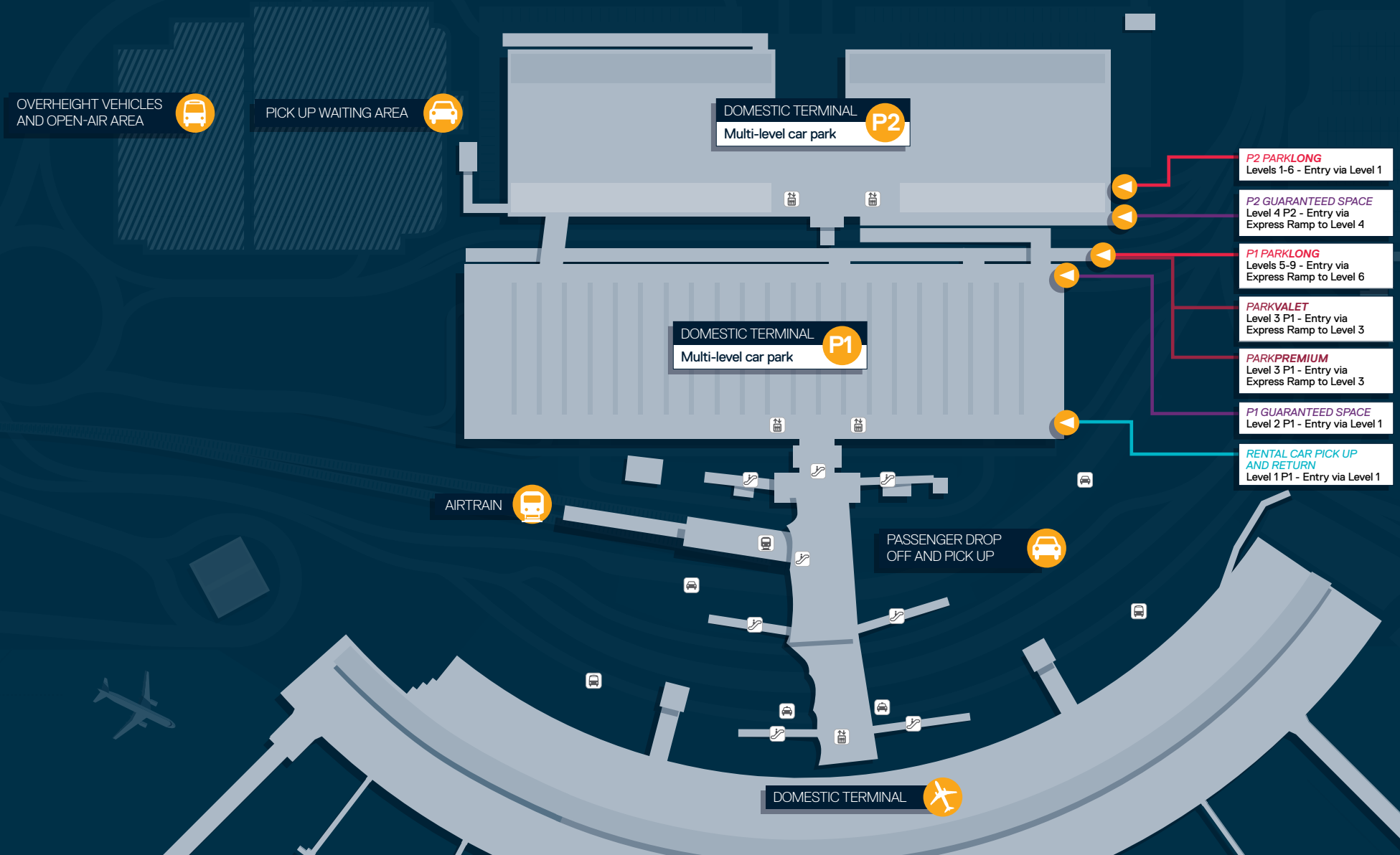
